An Act to amend the Traffic Ordinance

[12TH DECEMBER, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic Ordinance (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1962, and shall be read as one with the Traffic Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the Ordinance). Short title and construction Cap. 168

2. Section 11 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting from the last two lines of subsection (1) thereof the commas and words “, not exceeding thirty-five per centum of the fee payable for the corresponding yearly licence.” Section 11 of Cap. 168 amended

3. Section 63 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately after subsection (4) thereof the following new subsection:— Section 63 of Cap. 168 amended

“(5) Where, as the result of the inspection of any vehicle pursuant to the provisions of this section, any person is convicted of an offence against this Ordinance or any rules made thereunder the commission of which offence was revealed by such inspection, the court by which such person is convicted shall, in addition to any other penalty which it may impose or any other order which it may make, order the person so convicted to pay an inspection fee of twenty shillings.”

4. Section 71 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after paragraph (b) thereof the following new paragraph to be lettered (bb):— Section 71 of Cap. 168 amended

“(bb) providing for the issue by licensing authorities to persons applying therefor and paying the prescribed fee of index marks and numbers to be used by such persons on motor vehicles owned by them;”
