**An Act to make provision for the Imposition of a Levy in respect of the Occupation of Accommodation in certain Hotels, for payment of the sums raised by such Levy to the Tanganyika National Tourist Board and for matters incidental thereto**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Hotel Accommodation (Imposition of Levy) Act, 1962, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notice in the *Gazette*, appoint.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires-  
"adult" means a person of or over the age of eighteen years;

"hotel" means any establishment intended for the reception of travellers or visitors who may choose to stay therein and carried on with a view to profit or gain, but does not include-

- (a) any such establishment which has accommodation for less than six guests;
- (b) any such establishment which provides sleeping accommodation only in dormitories; or
- (c) any Government rest-house;

"Minister" means the Minister for the time being responsible for matters relating to the tourist industry;

"night" means the interval between seven o'clock in the evening and six o'clock on the next following morning-;

"specified hotel" means any hotel specified for the purposes of this Act by regulations made under section 5;

"Tourist Board" means the Tanganyika National Tourist Board established by section 3 of the Tanganyika National Tourist Board Act, 1962.

3.-(1) Where any adult occupies, in return for payment, sleeping accommodation in any specified hotel there shall be payable by such person a levy of two shillings in respect of each night or part of a night during which such accommodation was occupied by him.

(2) The levy imposed by subsection (1) shall be collected by such persons and in such manner as may be prescribed.

(3) All sums collected pursuant to this section shall be paid, by such persons, in such manner and at such intervals as may be prescribed, to the Tourist Board and shall, when so paid, form part of the funds thereof.

4. Any member of the Tourist Board or any person employed by the Tourist Board who is authorized by such Board in that behalf, may at any reasonable time, for the purpose of ensuring that the provisions of this Act have been complied with, enter any specified hotel and inspect the register of guests maintained therein and any other books, accounts and documents relating to the number of guests accommodated at the hotel during any period or the number of nights each such guest was so accommodated.

Regulations


5. (1) The Minister may make regulations-

- (a) for the better carrying out of the purposes of this Act;
- (b) for prescribing anything which by this Act may be prescribed; and
- (c) specifying the hotels which shall, for the purposes of this Act, be specified hotels.

(2) Regulations made under subsection (1)-

- (a) may be made between the passing of this Act and the date of coming into operation thereof; and
- (b) may contain penalties for the breach thereof not exceeding a fine of two thousand shillings or imprisonment for a period of three months or both such fine and imprisonment.
