An Act to apply a further sum of one million, six hundred and sixty-seven thousand, five hundred and eighty-nine pounds out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, and to appropriate the supply granted

[13TH JULY, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1,(1) This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1961-1962) (No. 2) Act, 1962.

(2) The expressions used in this Act shall have the meanings respectively ascribed thereto in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1961.

Appropriations-in-aid

2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1962, the sum of one million, six hundred and sixty-seven thousand, five hundred and eighty-nine pounds.

3. The sum granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the amounts specified in the second and third columns of the Schedule to this Act.

4. In addition to the sums granted out of the Consolidated Fund under section 2, there may be applied out of any moneys directed, under section 9 of the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1961, to be applied as appropriations-in-aid, the amounts respectively set forth in the fourth column of the Schedule to this Act.
