An Act to amend the Judicature and Application of Laws Ordinance, 1961, so as further to modify the Fugitive Offenders Act, 1881, in its Application to Tanganyika

[2ND MARCH, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Judicature and Application of Laws Short title Ordinance, 1961 (Amendment) Act, 1962, and shall be read as one with and construction the Judicature and Application of Laws Ordinance, 1961 (hereinafter Ord. 1961 called the Ordinance).

2. Part I of the Schedule to the Ordinance is hereby amended by Schedule deleting sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph 2 thereof and substituting there-Ordinance for the following new sub-paragraphs to be lettered (d), (e) and (f) amended respectively:—

- "(d) A fugitive offender shall not be liable to be returned under the Act if any offence in respect of which the warrant for his apprehension has been issued is an offence of a political character, or if he proves to the satisfaction of the magistrate before whom he is brought under the provisions of the Act or of a superior court that such warrant has been issued to obtain his return in order that he may be tried and punished or be detained for an offence of a political character.
- (e) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of the Act as modified by this Ordinance, a fugitive offender shall not be returned under Part II of the Act if the Governor-General orders that he shall not be so returned.
- (f) For the purposes of Part II of the Act, Tanganyika shall form a group with the following territories and with no other territories:—

Aden Colony (which includes Perim and the Kuria Muria Islands)

India

Kamaran

Kenya Colony and Protectorate

Mauritius

Pakistan

Uganda Protectorate

Zanzibar Protectorate.".
