An Act to amend the Provident Fund (Government Employees) Ordinance

[.....]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Provident Fund (Government Employees) Ordinance (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be read as one with the Provident Fund (Government Employees) Ordinance (hereinafter called the Ordinance).

2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 4 of the Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting the commas and words “, and who is in receipt of a salary which is not less than one hundred shillings a month,” which occur in the third and fourth lines thereof; and
- (b) by deleting the words “at a salary of not less than one hundred shillings a month” occurring in the sixth and seventh lines thereof.

3. Section 5 of the Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting the words “Accountant-General” occurring in the eighth line of subsection (1) thereof and substituting therefor the words “Accounting Officer”; and
- (b) by adding immediately below subsection (4) the following new subsection:—


“(5) For the purposes of this section, “Accounting Officer” means a Permanent Secretary of a Ministry or the Head of an Independent Department of Government.”.

4. Subsection (1) of section 8 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words “and shall begin to accrue in respect of each sum deposited and each bonus on the first day of the month next following the day on which the deposit is deemed to be made or the

bonus is required to be credited" occurring in the third, fourth, fifth and sixth lines thereof and substituting therefor the words "on the 30th June and 31st December in each year on balances brought forward at the beginning of each half year. No interest will be payable for fractions of six months."
