An Act to impose and alter certain Taxes and Duties and to amend certain Enactments relating to Taxes and Duties and for purposes connected therewith

[16TH JUNE, 1972]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Act, 1972.

Short title

PART I

EXCISE DUTIES

2. This Part shall be read as one with the Excise Tariff Ordinance and shaft be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th June, 1972.

Construction and commencement Cap. 332

3. The First Schedule to the Excise Tariff Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting item 12 (which relates to soap, etc.), item 13 (which relates to fabrics, etc.) and item 14 (which relates to, varnishes and lacquers, etc.) and by substituting therefor the following new items -

New section IA. added to Cap. 196

13. The Export Tax Ordinance is amended by adding, immediately below section I the following section:-

"Interpreta-1A. In this Ordinance "Minister" means the Minister for tion the time being responsible for finance.".

Amendment to proviso to section 2 Cap. 196

14. The Export Tax Ordinance is amended in section 2, in the proviso, by deleting the words "for the time being responsible for financial matters" which occur immediately after the words "the Minister" in the second line of the said proviso.
