| <p>1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2 for Financial Year 1975/76) (No. 2) Act, 1976 and shall be read and as one with the Appropriation Act, 1975.</p> <p>(2) The expressions used in this Act shall have the meanings respectively ascribed thereto in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance.</p> <p>2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted for the Service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1976 the sum of one hundred seventeen million, one hundred seventy-five thousand, four hundred fifty-seven shillings.</p> <p>3. The sum granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the amounts specified in the second and fifth columns of the Schedule to this Act.</p> <p>4.-(1) The Minister may at any time or times not later than the thirtieth day of June, 1976 borrow within or outside Tanzania or partly within and partly outside Tanzania any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole one hundred seventeen million, one hundred seventy-five thousand, four hundred fifty-seven shillings by way of loan, advance, the issue of bills as bank overdraft and on such terms and conditions as the Minister may deem expedient, and may charge any such loan or advance of any of the assets of the United Republic (including securities forming part of Consolidated Fund).</p> | <p>Short title and interpretation</p> <p>Cap. 439</p> <p>Issue of Shs. 117,175,457 out of the Consolidated Fund</p> <p>Appropriation of moneys voted</p> <p>Power of the Minister to borrow</p> |

(2) Any money borrowed under this section shall be placed to the credit of the exchequer account and shall form part of the Consolidated Fund, and be available in any manner in which such Fund is available'

(3) Any money borrowed under this section shall be subject to repayment not later than thirty-first day of October, 1976 and an sum required for the payment of any money so borrowed, and any interest payable thereon shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
